1. AKATOMO'ANGA

Ei akatomo ia tatou ki roto i te toru o te nuti leta no teia mataiti, teia ta Davida kia Golia, "Te aere maira koe kiaku nei ma te koke e te korare e te paruru: te aere atu nei ra au kia koe ma te ingoa o lehova Sabaota ra, te Atua no te au nuku o Israela ra, tei akavaavaaia e koe na" (1 Samuela 17.45).

Kia orana akaou e taku au taeake rave angaanga i roto i te Atu, pera kotou e te au mema i roto i te akarongo, to kotou au tokorua e pera te anau katoatoa. E tau ia tatou kia akameitaki i te mana katoatoa koia tei oronga mai i teia tikaanga manea kia aravei akaou tatou na roto i teia pepa akakitekite no te 12 o te taime, e no te toru o te taime i teia mataiti 2007. Aroa tatake ki te au tavini e te au oa rave angaanga o te Atua e tapapa mai nei i teia tuatau no te tere mai ki te uipaanga maata a teia marama ki mua Tiurai.

Me e au nuti ta kotou tei anoano kia tauruia ki roto i teia au tataanga ki mua, tuku mai kiaku me kore ki to tatou opati i Takamoa. 2. TUATUA AKAMAARAARA NO TE AU MATA KI TE UIPAANGA MAATA

E mea puapinga e te au taeke i te pa enua, Nuti Reni e Autireria, kia akaoki akaou iatu teia au akamaaraaraanga i raro nei kia maru to kotou tereanga mai ki te uipaanga maata. Tena te katoaanga i te au akamaramaramaanga tei roto i te nuti leta numero 11; ka kiriti ua mai au i te au ngai puapinga e pera tetai au mea rikiriki kare i ona ki roto i te reira tataanga:

- ✓ Me ka tae vave mai kotou ki Rarotonga nei, ka noo kotou ki te au taeake/kopu tangata e tae uatu ki te Maanakai 21 Tiurai, te ra e tomo ei kotou ki roto i te Ekalesia tei akonoia no kotou.
- ✓ Ko tetai uatu e aere mai nei ki te uipaanga maata tei anoano i te pereo (transport) no te tiki atu ki te airport ma te kave atu ki toou ngai nooanga i mua ake i te uipaanga maata, ka rauka i te opati maata i te tauturu atu ia kotou no te mea te vai nei to tatou transport ei tiki atu ia kotou. Ringi mai ia Nga Mitiau, Jimmy Metuakore, e Steak Potoru i roto i to tatou opati i Takamoa (phone 26546) ma te akakite atu kia ratou i to kotou flight numbers, arrival dates, e te vai atura.
- ✓ Ka anoanoia te katoatoa kia pou mai ki Takamoa, **9.00am Maanakai 21 Tiurai** no te retitaanga e pera te apai atu anga i ta kotou au pepa uipaanga. Mei Takamoa, aru atu ei kotou i to kotou au metua tiaki ia kotou i roto i nga Ekalesia e 6. Ka tai'i kotou me aere tika ki roto i te Ekalesia ma te kore e na mua mai ki Takamoa.
- ✓ Ka anoanoia kotou kia apai mai i te meneti o te uipaanga maata 2005 tei tuku takere iatu. Okotai rai meneti o te uipaanga 2005 te ka oronga iatu mei Takamoa ki te Ekalesia okotai. No reira e rua korua ka aere mai ki te uipaanga, tena tetai meneti teia kotou, tei Takamoa nei tetai. Kare e spare meneti e oronga akaou iatu me akaruke atu koe/korua i tena tei tuku takere iatu.
- ✓ I te Sabati 22 Tiurai, kia pou mai te katoatoa ki Takamoa ki te ngutuare o te Puapii Maata i te ora 9.00am. Ka aravei tatou ki reira, akatanotano ei i te au mea katoatoa, ireira tatou tere kapiti ei ki te nao o te Atua. I te mea e ka apiapi a tai i te Sinai Hall, e ngari ake kia park i te au apinga akaoro ki uta i Takamoa me kore ki runga i te mataara aere atu ei ki te National Auditorium. Ka aiteite teia akanoonooanga ki to te Sabati 29 Tiurai o te topirianga.
- ✓ Ka anoano maataia te katoatoa kia noo ki roto i te uipaanga, koia oki Monite, Ruirua, popongi Paraparau, popongi Varaire. Tena te Ruitoru, afternoon Paraparau, afternoon Varaire, all day Maanakai, ei au tuatau rave i to kotou uaorai au anoano takake mei to te uipaanga.
- ✓ Tena nga patianga a te Are Ariki, e mea meitaki kia ariki kotou e te au taeake.
- ✓ Tena te akakoroanga o te ra taeanga Evangelia i te Ruitoru, e mea meitaki kia tae atu kotou e te au taeake.
- ✓ Te aronga ka aere mai ki te uipaanga koia oki:
 - Ekalesia Avarua e Arorangi: Orometua, 2 mata i te Ekalesia okotai.
 - Te katoaanga o te au Ekalesia CICC: Orometua, 1 mata i te Ekalesia okotai.

- Akarakara (obsever): okotai mei roto i nga Ekalesia e 6 i Rarotonga nei ua, kare o te pa enua, Nuti Reni e Autireria.
- Au Orometua akatainuia i raro ake i te CICC e kare i rauka ake ta ratou Ekalesia.
- Au Orometua e Ekalesia ou ta ratou kare i arikiia ake (meia Miramar, Mayfair, Ashburton, etc.), ko kotou ua te ka aere mai kare e mata me kore akarakara e aru mai
- Akonoanga e pirianga tona ki te CICC, tena kua akamarama iatu i roto i te nuti leta numero 10.

3. AKAPAPAANGA O TE AU MATA KI TE UIPAANGA MAATA

Tena te akapapaanga **mua** o te au mata ki te uipaanga kua topiria mai ki muri i teia nuti leta (**Annex I**). I roto i teia akapapaanga, kua akamouia te reira ki runga i teia au mea i raro nei:

- (a) Akakiteanga/akapapuanga mei te au Ekalesia e koai to ratou e aere mai nei.
- (b) Patianga mei te au mata no te au Ekalesia i Rarotonga nei ta ratou i inangaro i te noo no te mea kare ratou i noo ake ki roto i te reira au Ekalesia.
- (c) Akatanotanoanga i te numero tangata kia aiteite me kore auraka kia tuke maata roa i roto i nga Ekalesia e 6 i Rarotonga nei. No teia tumuanga, penei kare i rauka te au patianga katoatoa kia arikiia, no reira me ko kotou tetai i roto i teia turanga, kia rava te akakoromaki.

Tena katoa ka kite kotou i roto i te akapapaanga, te au Ekalesia kare e ingoa i akakiia ki roto. Ko te aiteanga koia oki kare i tae mai ake kiaku te ingoa o te au mata mei roto mai i te reira au Ekalesia. I roto oki i nga **nuti leta numero 10 & 11**, kua oronga iatu te akamaroiroianga e kia pou mai te ingoa o te au mata kiaku i te openga o te marama i topa ia Me. I na, kare i pou mai tena te kite ra kotou. Me kare oki kotou e teia au Ekalesia e rapurapu mai i to kotou au ingoa, kare e rauka to kotou ngai nooanga i roto i nga Ekalesia i te akapapu i te epetoma o te uipaanga, riro atura ireira ei pekapekaanga no tatou me tae mai kotou. Ka vaao atu au i teia na kotou e akaoti atu.

4. AU PEPA UIPAANGA

I roto i te pepa akakitekite tei topiri iatu ki muri i te nuti leta numero 11 (**Annex I p.12**), te akatakara e ko te au pepa no te uipaanga e tu mai nei, ka emere iatu te reira kia ratou e emere ta ratou. Ko te tumuanga ki konei koia oki kia rauka i te au mata kia akarakara, penei uriuri atu ki ta ratou Ekalesia, i mua ake ka tere mai ei ki te uipaanga. Ka rave iatu teia i te epetoma mua o Tiurai, i roto i te irinakianga e kua pou mai te au ripoti katoatoa, ta matou i Rarotonga nei, e ta korua e nga Konitara Ekalesia o Nuti Reni e Autireria. Tena i roto i te nuti leta numero 11 (**Annex III p.16**) te akanoonoanga o ta kotou ripoti ka tata mai. Akakoromaki mai te au Ekalesia kare a kotou emere, kare e tuku iatu te au pepa na roto i te postal mail, ko te tureti me tae atu kua akaruke takere kotou no te tere mai ki Rarotonga nei.

Teia tetai mea puapinga kia kite mai kotou katoatoa e aere mai nei ki te uipaanga, te aronga e computer ta ratou e pera kotou kare e computer i teia taime. Te vai nei teia apinga a te papaa tona ingoa e computer flash stick, i roto paa i to tatou reo, e rakau manamana, mei te 1 – 3 ini tona roroa. E taangaanga iana teia rakau i roto i te au opati katoatoa e, e computer tetai. Ko te oko iaia, tei runga i te maata o te au mea tana ka apai (storage size). Ko te au mea mama te moni, tei runga paa i te \$20 - \$50, e mama ake paa i Nuti Reni e Autireria, te oko katoaia nei oki i roto i te au toa computers i Rarotonga nei. E mea puapinga i toku manako kia oko/apai mai kotou i tetai na kotou, okotai i te Ekalesia kua rava rai.

Teia oki tona akakoroanga e te puapinga, me oti te uipaanga, ka tukuia ki runga i teia rakau, te au pepa me kore ripoti katoatoa o te uipaanga maata, te tutu (group photo) te ka neneilia i te ra mua o te uipaanga, te meneti e pera te resolutions o te uipaanga maata 2007. Me oki ireira kotou i muri ake i te uipaanga, e rua ireira a kotou akapapaanga pepa uipaanga, tei oti i te neneilia, e pera to runga i teia rakau. Ko teia te akanoonoanga (trend) e aere nei i teia tuatau no runga i te au pepa uipaanga. Ka vaao atu au i teia kia kotou kia akara ma te paunu marie atu i tona puapinga.

5. TUTAKIANGA I TE AU OROMETUA I MUA AKE I TE TAUINGA

E manako teia tei uri te kumiti akaaere e kua ariki e ko tei tau teia i te au Ekalesia katoatoa kia rave. Kua manako te kumiti akaaere e, kia tutaki te au Ekalesia katoatoa i to ratou Orometua (ratou te ka taui iatu ki tetai Ekalesia ke) **no te toeanga o teia mataitii i mua ake ka akaruke mai ei ratou ia kotou**. Teia ireira te aiteanga, ko te au Orometua ka tomo ki roto i te au Ekalesia ou, kare ratou e tutakiia e ta ratou Ekalesia ou e tae uatu kia Tianuare 2008, ireira ratou e tutaki ia'i ta ratou moni (stipend) mua i roto i ta ratou Ekalesia ou. Ko te tumuanga maata i pera ei, kia maru te turanga tauianga o te au Orometua i te tuanga o ta ratou moni. Ringi mai i te Mou Moni Maata me kua anoanoia tetai akamarama akaou anga.

6. NUTI NA TE VAINETINI O TE EKALESIA CLAYTON

Kua raveia atu ta matou uipaanga mua i roto ia Peperuare i teia nataiti no te akaou anga atu i to matou ruru kumiti, e ko teia i reira to ratou au ingoa no te mataiti 2007:

1. Mama Orometua: Matangaro William – Peretiteni, Mama Tauturu Orometua: Teina Morara Mairi – Tauturu Peretiteni, Tekeretere – Moeroa Ngapare, Tauturu Tekeretere – Tangi Isamaela, Mou Moni – Louise Abela Mokoha, Tauturu Mou Moni – Vaevae Maka, Mata ki roto i te Uipaanga Diakono – Muri Isamaela. Ko tena i reira to matou au tumu toa no te akatere i to matou pai na roto i teia mataiti 2007, ma te irinaki o te au mama e ka tere au ua te au mea katoatoa i roto i teia mataiti ma te kore e tai'i ki roto i te au urilia tukeke penei ka tupu mai.
2. Kua akatuera te angaanga a te Vainetini i roto i te Orao o Mati e kua akatapu katoatoaia atu te au taonga o te Ekalesia e tae uatu ki te au taonga o te au putuputuanga i roto i te Ekalesia. Te rua o te Tapati, koia te ra 11 o Mati, kua raveia te pure akamataanga i te au angaanga a te putuputuanga Vaijanetini e kua riro teia pureanga e na te au ruru kumiti i akateretere mai. Kua rave katoaia atu tetai uapou i muri ake i te pureanga.
3. I roto i te marama Aperira i te tuatau o te Easter, kua raveia atu ta matou pureanga i roto i te aiai Paraparau, e kua kakau te katoatoa i te kakau teatea mei te aronga mamaata e tae uatu ki ta matou au tamariki, kua angaia te katoatoa ki te Orao i te reira po. I te popongi Varaire kua raveia atu ta matou pure mateanga (Good Friday) i te 9.00am e kua kerekere te katoatoa. I roto i teia tuatau nei tei rotopu te tere o te Whiterock Ekalesia ia matou tei tere mai mei Cairns. Kua riro e na te au Ekalesia metua e 4 i akonokono i to ratou oraanga i rotopu ia matou.
4. Kua raveia ta matou pure kapiti ki te Ekalesia Clayton, koia nga Ekalesia metua e 4: Reservoir, Dandenong, Springvale e Clayton, e pera te tere mei Cairns mai. Kua riro te akonokono i te oraanga o nga Ekalesia e na te Clayton Ekalesia i akateretere mai. Kua mataora tika'i te au angaanga tei raveia. Kua riro te putuputuanga Vainetini ei tauturu i te au angaanga tei anoanoia no te reira ra, koia oki kua akaputuputu mai te au mama i te ei no te akaei atu i te au taeake mei Cairns mai e pera te au taeake mei roto mai i nga Ekalesia e 4 i Melbourne nei. Kua maroiroi te au mama i te akaputu mai i ta ratou tuanga ei, karanga au e kua akaputu mai te au mama e taki rua ngauru ei i te tangata okotai no te akaei atu i teia urupu tangata, kua rava tika'i te ei a te au mama. Pera katoa, kua akaputu mai te au mama i ta ratou apinga akaputu koia taki tai tatini tea towel ei apinga aroa na te putuputuanga vainetini ki te tere no Cairns e pera te tikiro koia e \$200.00. Kia akameitakiia te au mama no teia tu maroiroi.
5. Kua akapupua te au mama no te tuanga o te fundraising e 4 pupu. I roto i te au marama takitai, ka riro e takitai pupu i te kimi mai i ta ratou ravenga no te kimikimianga moni. Tei runga rai ia ratou eaa te kimi moni ta ratou i anoano i te rave. I roto i te au pupu tatakitai e au akaaere rai to ratou e na ratou e akarakara mai i te au angaanga ka anoanoia ratou kia rave. Ko te pupu mua, kua rave atu ratou i ta ratou kimikimianga moni e kua rauka mai \$1,000.00 no te tauturu atu i te pute a te putuputuanga. Na ratou te kimi moni i roto i te marama Mati. I roto ia Peperuare na te pupu 2, kare i tae mai ake ta ratou ripoti e eia a ratou tuaanga i rauka mai.
6. I roto ia Me, ka raveia atu te akaepaepaanga i te ra o te au mama, ko teia tuanga nei ka riro te reira na te au papa e te au mapu e akateretere mai. Ka riro teia ei surprise na ratou ki te au mama. Ko te tuatau e rave ia'i koia e aiai Maanakai. Inara kare ratou e akakite mai e, eaa ta ratou ka rave, no reira ka tiaki ua atu te au mama no runga i teia tuanga nei.
7. Ko tetai tuanga maata a te au mama e tapapa atu nei koia oki ko te tauianga Orometua. E tuanga rai ta te au mama no runga i teia koia te akateateamamaoanga i ta ratou apinga aroa ki te mama e te papa Orometua. No reira te akateateamamao nei rai te au mama no teia tuanga.

Te vai atura rai te au angaanga mamaata toe a te putuputuanga Vainetini e tu mai nei. Irinaki au e kua rava teia no tatou i roto i teia tuatau. Irinaki katoa au e ka riro teia taku e ripoti atu nei ei pumaanaanga ki to kotou ngakau katoatoa, e kia riro ua rai te Vaerua Mana o te Atua i te itiki ia tatou ki te ngai okotai. Ei konei tatou i te tuataua i tona aroa ua, Amene.

7. NUTI MEI TE EKALESIA ATIU

Tere o te Mou Moni Maata ki Atiu

I te tuatau o te Easter Weekend kua tere atu au ki Atiu no te orote. Ko au e taku vase e pera tetai au taeake angaanga oku e ta ratou vase/tane/anau, 12 matou i te katoatoa. Kua akaruke atu to matou pairere ia Rarotonga i te ora 1.00pm e kua tae atu ki Atiu i te ora 1.35pm. Kua araveiia mai matou e Mrs Nga Paiere Mokoroa i te mea e ka noo atu matou ki roto i to raua au are tei karanga ia e ko te TAPARERE LODGES. Kia oti matou i te check-in ki roto i to matou au are nooanga, e kua oronga ia mai to matou taviri ngutupa are e te taviri patikara/motoka, kua aere atu matou tutaka i te au oire i Atiu i mua ake ka pou atu ei te reira ra.

Pure Aiai Paraparau - Kai Ora te Katoatoa

I te reira aiai Paraparau kua aere atu au ki te pure tei matau ua ia i roto i ta tatou akonoanga CICC e ko te pure kaianga ora na te katoatoa te ka tae ki te pure, mei te tamariki e tae uatu kite au aronga ruaine. Kua vaitata rai mei te 200 tuma au tangata tei aere mai kite pure i te reira pure anga. Kakau teatea te katoatoa i te reira pureanga. Kua kite mai te au taeake taku i matau atu ana i te tuatau o te uipaanga maata e kua poitirere ratou i toku tae atu anga ki roto ia ratou. Kua aravei katoa atu au i te Orometua Ina Moetaua i te akaoti anga te pure anga. Meitaki e te maruarua te au imene tei imene'ia i te pure, kua tau mari ki te ara tia o te reira ra. Kua vaitata rai e mapu te nui anga o te au tangata tei tae mai ki te pure.

Poitirere katoa au i te maatamaata o to ratou are pure Ziona Tapu. Iaku i noo ki te nooanga i muri roa kare e rongo takataka meitaki iatu na te Orometua no te maatamaata o te Are Pure. Manea katoa a roto i te Are Pure, a mua i te atarau, te au fans ou ka rua ake rai epetoma i te taangaanga ia anga. Kia akaoti te pureanga kua matakakiti atu matou i te au akatutu anga a te anau Uniform (BB,GB,GG) no runga i to lesu akava'ia anga, te takingakino angaia e te akasatauroia anga. Kua raveia teia ki tetai tua mai o te Are Pure e ngai atea ua (open air). Manea e te mako tika'i te reia rave angaanga na te anau Uniform o Atiu. Vaerua maroiroi taku i kite atu ki roto i te reira angaanga tei raveia. Kua akatuera katoaia te weekend camp a te Uniform Organisation o Atiu i te reira aiai Paraparau e kua rave iatu ki roto i to ratou hall maata koia te CICC Hall i mua i te Kainga Orometua.

Pure Mateanga (Good Friday)

I te Varaire kua oki akaou atu au ki te pure mateanga i te ora 9.00am. Vaitata katoa mei te 200 tuma au tangata tei tae mai ki te pure. Numero meitaki teia i na tetai o te au Diakono mai ei kiaku. Kakau kerekere te katoatoa e te mako katoa te au akateretereanga pure, te au imene tau meitaki ki te ara tia koia te akakoroanga o te akamaaraanga i te mateanga o te Atu.

Pure Tuakaouanga (Easter Sunday)

I te Maanakai kua tae mai te Diakono nana te rave angaanga no te pure popongi Sabati i te pati mai kia rave atu au i te reira tuanga. Manuia kua apai atu au i taku koke (Buka Tapu) e toku rakei no te are pure ki Atiu mari ua kare e pereue. Kua timata au i te reo maata kia rongo mai te au tangata e noo ra ki muri i te are pure. Kua apai au i te tuanga tia o te Maanakai, koia a Mareko 15:33-47, irava 34 i te pae openga. Kua iti mai te au tangata (mei tetai 50) tei tae mai ki te pure, mei te mea atu rai e kua aite rai kia Petero ma, kare i maara e ka tu akaou mai a lesu mei te mate mai i tera mua o te epetoma. I te pure avatea 10.00am, na te Uniform te au imene e te tiaki atarau, e pera katoa i te pure aiai. Kia akaoti te pure aiai, kua aere atu te katoatoa ki roto i te CICC Hall no te matakakiti i te au aitamu akatutuanga a te anau Uniform no runga i te tuakaouanga o lesu. Mataora katoa e te manea teia angaanga tei raveia, e i muri ake te kai anga ti vai remene e te pai meika Atiu.

Akaraanga na te Mou Moni

Kua kite atu au i te mataora, te maroiroi e te oaoa katoa o te Orometua Ina Moetaua e te vase i te akaruru i te Ekalesia na roto i te au angaanga taku i kite ia raua i te piri ki te Ekalesia e te Uniform group. Te maroiroi katoa ra te tokooti au metua pakari taku i komakoma atu (meia Tearai Mokoroa e Moetaua Boaza), te au metua vase ruaine, i te turuturu i te anau Uniform taku i kite i tae ki roto i te au pureanga, e pera te au akakoroanga o te Uniform group. Inara kia maara katoa ia tatou e kua na roto mai teia Ekalesia i tetai au manamanata tai'i no te au akaaere tei akamavete i te au mema. Te pokia katoaia nei te Ekalesia e te au manamanata politics e pera te au Evangelia keke tei tautai katoa ki roto i te Ekalesia no tetai au mema no ratou.

11. TERE O TE CIMAVA GROUP KI AITUTAKI E MAUKE

Aitutaki (7 – 11 May 2007)

During 7 – 11 May 2007, Rev. Nio Mare of the Avarua Ekalesia CICC led a team to Aitutaki to conduct a community workshop. The name of the group which Rev. Nio is chairman is the Cook Islands Men Against Violence Action Group (CIMAVA). This is a branch of the Punanga Tauturu, an NGO dedicated to reducing violence in the home. Others in the group which went to Aitutaki included; Secretary Iro Rangi (Deputy Mayor – Puaikura), Tekura Potoru (Village Council – Takuvaine), Edward Browne (Probation Officer), Pastor Uma Katu (RAC President), Ena Dance (Volunteer), and Vira Tavioni (Volunteer). Their workshop concentrated on Gender Awareness, Family Violence, Rape, Child Abuse, and Spiritual Marriage.

Upon arriving in Aitutaki the CIMAVA group in the evening held a meeting with the Aitutaki Island Leaders; RAC Members, Ui Ariki, Village Councils, NGO Leaders, Church Leaders, Assistant Island Secretary and Mayor. The meeting was well attended, the Chairman of the CIMAVA gave an outline for the purpose of our trip to Aitutaki and also presented the programme for the week..

Topic covered in the workshop were as follows:

Sex and Gender Awareness

- What is SEX and GENDER?
- How would you define them?
- Roles for men and women in our society

Spiritual Marriage

- What is Spiritual Marriage?
- How to live in a faithful and honest relationship with your partner?

My Past Experience on Violence

Our last speaker for the night gave a testimony/sharing about her life in the past. How she manage to leave a violence and abusive situation.

- Domestic Violence, Child Abuse

The lecturer gave an outline on domestic violence and abuses on children, youth and old people.

Domestic and Family Violence

- What are the causes and effects of violence against women and children
- How to solve the problem
- The four elements of violence and abuse; Physical, Sexual, Emotional, Verbal

Sexual Assault

- What causes Sexual Assault?
- Does alcohol play a part in it?
- How can you stop this kind of behaviour

Rape

- What is Rape?
- What causes Rape and the effects?
- The crime act on Rape

Domestic Violence

This is a continual topic from Day 4 session with the awareness.

- How can you help/assist the victim and family?
- How can you learn about the problem?
- The pain and sorrows that have been caused
- Don't leave our children alone at home
- How can you tell that person is living in a happy situation?

There were a lot of questions raised by the audience especially from some parents whom there children have been victims of Rape. They have reported the matter to the police but nothing has been done. Every lecturer was given the opportunity to say a few words of thanks to the participants. The workshop was well attended by young and old generations. The presentations by the lecturers was done in our local mother tongue, Maori, which gave a more understanding of the topics by the participants. Workshop was officially closed by Rev Toko Ongoua and followed with a feast provided by the Tautu Ekalesia.

The CIMAVA group would like to give their appreciation to the President of CIANGO, Mrs Vereara Maeva-Taripo, for assisting us in providing/seeking funds through EU, Ministry of Internal Affairs, for funding of airfare for the RAC President and lastly to the President, Executive Committee and Staff of Punanga Tauturu for the ongoing support you give us, stationeries and handouts, also for providing the funds, for our Chairman's trips. May God Bless and enriches you. Meitaki Atupaka.

Mauke (19 – 23 March 2007)

The workshop was attended by the VAWC0-ordinator Mii Daniela, Chairman/Pastor CIMAVA Men's group Nio Mare, Deputy Mayor of Puaikura Iro Rangi, Mr.Tekura Potoru (Chairman Takuvaine Council) and Probation Officer Edward Browne. The programme was prepared and confirmed through CIMAVA Mens group Chairman Pastor Nio Mare channelled through to the Mauke CICC Secretary and the representative of the Religious Advisory Council requested for Family Violence and Child Abuse training with the assistances and facilitated by the VAWC0-ordinator of Punanga Tauturu Mii Daniela, confirmed programmes and participants. The Mauke CICC Secretary informed Chairman Pastor Nio Mare that there will be brief meeting on the programme on the first day arrival to the island.

Topics covered in the Mauke workshop were the same as those covered in Aitutaki. The following were the main areas discussed:

- Participants discussed on the matter of the people who are uneducated to learn about issues on child abuse, verbal abuse against their children which triggered by verbal violence to commit such activities.
- Young girl explained and discussed her experienced with birthparents denial against her where she stated that the parents should love their children to the best of their ability.
- Parents spoke out his misinterpreted of the matter of child physical abuse his children, thought it is normal to him and what he has learned from the workshop about his behavioural of violence and requested to train him as one of the educator referred to the topics presented by trainers.
- The matter of the parents who are lack of understanding to the issues raised by presenters. Participants were challenged by the matter raised and stated that parents should love their children and to love themselves referred to the scriptures encouraged them to better living within their homes.
- Participants spoke out concerns the lack of supports from the Public Servants such as; Police, Probation Officer and Welfare Officer roles to take full responsibilities of the welfare and the wellbeing of the people of Mauke. There were suggestion to form a committee for the public servants, included all the Pastors and Leaders within their community at large. Pastor Nio Mare stated that to refer that suggestion to the people to decide where to from here.

The workshop was well attended with the number of (65) participants, represented from different Church Leaders and members of CICC, Catholic members, SDA member, School Teachers and students, MP of the Island, Representative of the Ariki of Kimiangatau and Oiretumu Districts. There were positive feedbacks from participants requested for another follow up workshop with more references and video examples and experiences on family and young people's violence within their homes. There were requested for the next follow up workshop to allow people or victims who has been abused to give them time to discuss issues related to the abuse on children by their parents.

The participants requested for the parents to be train as counsellors and they requested for basic counselling skills training. There was a family with a 20 year old disabled young woman requested for urgent assistances to the family and to refer disable woman back to New Zealand to be place within Disable Home, ongoing process and communications to the DAT Team and Auckland PISS Team for the referral of the case. The team Punanga Tauturu and the CIMAVA Mens group would like to thank you all the people of Mauke (Akatokamanava) for your hospitality to the team and assisted us with our workshop training. (Te na ko nei te tuatua nate Atua, ko te mea teia e kite ei tatou e, e Tamariki tatou na te Atua – God Bless You All).

Kua pumaana te katoatoa i te au akamaramaanga tei oronga iatu, e i roto i toku irinakianga, kua takataka meitaki i teianei i rotopu i te au taeake tei tae mai e, eaa tika'i to ratou turanga i Tepuka i teia ra. No reira e te au taeake, tena ta tatou i uriuri, kua marama kotou i teia nei, teia kotou ireira te ikianga e te au mea ta kotou ka rave. Tena katoa te au updates ka tae atu na roto i te au tataanga o te nuti leta, e pera te au contacts o te kumiti akaaere, ringi mai me e au tai'i tetai a teia au tuatau ki mua.

Te oronga akaou atu nei ireira au i taku akameitakianga kia kotou katoatoa tei tae mai ki te uipaanga e no ta kotou arikirikianga mai iaku i muri ake i te uipaanga. Ka akamaroiro no te au tuatau ki mua i te akatupuanga i to kotou au manakonakoanga no Tepuka.

13. OPATI OU I TAKAMOA

Te rekareka nei te kumiti akaaere i te ripoti atu e ka akamata te au akateateamamaoanga no te angaanga ki runga i te opati ou (new administration office building) i Takamoa i muri ake i te uipaanga maata e tu mai nei. Kua arikiia oki teia akakoroanga (project) i roto i te uipaanga maata 2005, inara kare i rauka te angaanga i te akamata i roto i nga matait e rua i topa no tetai au tumuanga meitaki. Kua tamanakoia te moni ka pou ki runga i teia are e 2 ona taua, penei vaitata atu ki te \$1million.

Teia te uiaanga, teiea teia moni? Teia tona au pauanga i raro nei:

- (a) Tena teia kotou e te au Ekalesia. Kua kite kotou i tei akaotia i te uipaanga maata i topa ake nei, ta kotou au tuanga tei akatakaia no teia akakoroanga, no reira apaina mai me kore tukuna mai ta kotou tuanga. Kua peke takere ta tetai pae, kua akamata ta tetai pae i te tutaki rikiriki mai, te vai nei tetai maataanga Ekalesia kare i akamata ake i te tutaki mai. E 5 oki matait i teakanooia kia peke teia akatuangaanga, no reira akamaroiro mai.
- (b) Te aere maru ua mai nei te puapinga no roto i te akakoroanga kimi puapinga (project) i Tepuka. Ka riro teia project i te tauturu mai i te akakoronga o te opati ou.
- (c) Te vai nei te manakonakoanga no te topapa atu i te ngutupa o te au taokotaianga i vao mai i te basileia, mei te WCC, penei ka rauka tetai tauturu meia ratou.
- (d) Te vai katoa nei oki te banks i Rarotonga nei no te tarauanga i te moni me anoanoia.

E irinaki maata to te kumiti akaaere e me oti teia ngutuare, e tano ei e ka meitaki atu te akaterereanga o ta tatou nei akonoanga CICC. Kotou tei kite mata ana i te turanga o to tatou opati i teia ra, ka ariki kotou e kua tau mari teia ngutuare kia takore iatu e tetai mea ou kia akatuia.

14. TE AKAKOROANGA O TE EKALESIA E TE ITI TANGATA PAMATI

Mei tei taikuia i roto i te nuti leta numero 8, kua tuku te kumiti akaaere i te Orometua Tereapii Matakere ki Pamati i te marama Tiunu 2006 ei mono ia Papa Bill Marsters e ei tiaki i te Ekalesia, ei akatupu i te patianga a te reira Ekalesia tei tae mai ki te kumiti akaaere i te momua o te matait i topa. Kia marama mai tatou, okotai rai akonoanga i runga i teia enua, koia ta tatou akonoanga CICC. I na, ko te Ekalesia e pera te enua katoatoa ireira teia tei tuku mai i te patianga, e tei rauka i te atoro iatu e te kumiti akaaere.

I roto rai i te nuti leta numero 8, kua akakite iatu te manakonakoanga o te Ekalesia e pera te enua tangata Pamati koia oki te akatuanga i tetai puakapa no te Orometua. Kare e ngutuare mei teia te tu i runga i te enua, e i noo ua ana te Orometua Matakere e tona family ki te ngutuare o tetai mema Ekalesia. Kua rauka ra to ratou are kikau i teianei (temporary house), tapapa atu ei i te tuatau e tupu ei te moemoea no tetai

ngutuare tinamou, kare no te Orometua o teia ra ua, marira no te au Orometua ka tiaki i te Ekalesia a teia atu tuatau ki mua.

I te mea e kare teia akakoroanga i neke ake ki mua, kua manako mai ireira au kia taoki akaou atu ki te katoatoa i te inangaro o te Ekalesia e te enua tangata. Me kua anoano koe i te tauturu i teia akakoroanga manea e te puapinga, ka ariki rekarekaia tetai uatu tu tauturu; moni, apinga angaanga, rakau, punu, e te vai atura. E ngata te contact ia Palmerston i te mea e, e tai rai phone/fax i runga i te enua na te Telecom, te numero e 37683. Tetai ravenga, ringi mai iaku Tekeretere Maata me kore te Peretitene, me kore te Mou Moni, na matou e akatanotano ma te akanoonoo i te au tauturu kia tuku iatu ki teia Ekalesia.

I roto i te nuti leta numero 9, kua tuku iatu tetai au nuti mei te Ekalesia Pamati mai e ko kotou tei kite i te reira tataanga, irinaki au e kua pumaana kotou i te kite atu anga i teia Ekalesia meangiti e tupu meitaki maira i teia ra. Tetai uatu tei kore i kite ana i teia nuti leta, akakite tika (contact) mai kiaku kia tuku iatu tetai kapi naau. I roto rai i teia nuti leta numero 9, kua topiriia mai te leta pati tauturu a te Ekalesia e te enua ki te katoatoa no te akakoroanga o te kainga Orometua. Te topiri akaou atu nei au i teia leta, tena tei muri i te **Annex II** o teia nuti leta numero 12.

Tei runga ireira ia tatou e te katoatoa, te enua tangata Pamati e pera tatou kare e pirianga ki teia iti tangata, i te akara tangi mai i te reo o teia Ekalesia iti a tatou. Ko te Ekalesia meangiti rava atu teia i te Kuki Airani nei, e ko te enua meangiti rava atu te tare tangata; mei te 50 rai tangata e noo ana ki runga i teia enua. No te aa, te vai nei te au ngai rikiriki ta te kumiti akaaere ka rauka e kua rauka takere i te tauturu, na tatou ra na te katoatoa e akara i ta tatou ka rauka i te tauturu atu no teia akakoroanga maata. Me ka tika, akanoo (organise) mai kotou e te au arataki o te iti tangata Pamati i vao ake ia Pamati (Rarotonga, Nuti Reni, Autireria) i te au porokaramu kimikimianga moni, irinaki au e ko te ravenga teia e maru ma te mama ei te apainga e ka turuia e te iti tangata Kuki Airani i te au ngai e tei reira ratou.

Ko tetai oki manakonakoanga, tei runga i te maata o te puapinga te ka rauka mai, penei ka rava i te akameitaki (renovate) katoa atu i te are pure i runga i te enua. Na te katoaanga ra o te puapinga te ka rauka mai e papu ei e, me kua rava rai no te ngutuare o te Orometua, me ka rava no nga ngutuare roa'i e 2. No reira teia te reo openga o te enua Pamati, tangi mai tauturuia mai te akakoroanga, kia ruperupe te tupuanga o te Evangelia ora a to tatou Atu i runga i te enua.

Church Project on Palmerston Island

(translated by the Editor for the benefit of English-speaking Palmerston Islanders)

As reported in the CICC newsletter no.8, the CICC Executive Council in June 2006 appointed Rev. Tereapii Matakere as replacement for Papa Bill Marsters and to take care of the church on the island. This is in response to a request from the church to the Executive Council in early 2006. For the information of everyone, there is only one church on Palmerston, and that is the CICC. So the request for a minister therefore came from both the church and the people of Palmerston as a whole. The Council was happy to respond favourably to the request.

In the same CICC newsletter no.8, a plan by the church and the island to build a permanent residence for the minister was publicised. There has not been a ministers residence on Palmerston, and Rev. Matakere and his family stayed with a church member when they arrived. However, they recently moved into a temporary kikau hut, and looking forward to the day when a permanent residence is completed, not only for the current minister and his family, but for all future ministers who will be posted to Palmerston.

Because the project has not yet taken a step forward, I thought it might be an idea to repeat the plea from Palmerston to whoever out there is able to assist. So if you as an individual or group, either from Palmerston or from any other island, want to help out, feel free to do so either financially or in kind (building materials, etc.). It is hard to make contact with Palmerston, there is only one phone/fax on the island meantime, the Telecom number of 37683. Alternatively, contact me or the President or the Treasurer (our contacts are at the bottom of the first page of this newsletter). We can coordinate things on behalf of the island.

The CICC newsletter no.9 contained a report on events happening on the island and in the church; I trust that those who have had the chance to read this issue will be glad to know that the church there is alive and doing well. Anyone who may not have seen that issue, contact me directly, and I will be happy to forward you by email a copy. Also in the same issue, a letter from the island requesting assistance for the project, was attached. I am once again attaching this request (see **Annex II** of this current issue).

The plea is now once again going out to everyone, whether you come from Palmerston or not, to help out with this good and worthwhile cause. This is the smallest church in the Cook Islands and also the smallest island population of around 50. The CICC Executive Council have been able to help the Ekalesia out and is continuing to do so with minor requests, but this big project is for everyone willing and able enough to assist. An idea for you Palmerston Island leaders living outside of Palmerston (Rarotonga, NZ, Aust), please organise some fund raising programmes, I believe this will lessen the burden on individuals and I'm sure Cook Islanders, wherever they live, will gladly contribute.

The plan is this, depending on how much funds can be generated, that both the ministers residence and renovations to the church building itself may be able to be tackled at one go. So the final words from the church as well as the people of Palmerston are these: please help us with the project which can only contribute to furthering the development and advancement of God's work on the island for the betterment of Palmerston Island residents.

It is a great honour with pleasure to invite you all in this letter on behalf of the members of the church and the people of Palmerston to accept our humble request to find ways and means of fund-raising to build a Misison House. This house will be used to accommodate all Cook Islands Christian Church Pastors posted to the island, as well as visiting dignitaries who may not be able to be accommodated elsewhere on the island. We had a public meeting concerning this issue and the majority of the population have supported the idea.

However we cannot accomplish this project on our own without your consideration and support. That is why we are asking for your kind support and hoping that you will be able to contribute. The target is to raise \$100,000 for a fully furnished house including water storage facility. We feel that this may be the right time for us to inform you about this matter so that you will have ample time to discuss amongst yourselves. We are not setting any amount for people to contribute but to rely on whatever you can offer.

We will do our best on this end to raise as much as we can. Let us put our trust in the Lord for He is the God of Providence. We sincerely hope that you will accept our humble request and will await for your response. Please allow me to conclude this letter by quoting from the Book of Psalms to bind us all in the loving hands of our God. **Psalms 127.1:** "*Unless the Lord builds the house, they labour in vain who build it: unless the Lord guards the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.*" **Psalms 126.5:** "*Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy.*"

Ko teia `akapapa`anga `apii`anga kua moe katoatoa ratou i teia ra.

Mei te au `akapapa`anga i tuku ia atu i roto i te au CICC nuti leta tei topa ki muri, ko te `oraanga i Takamoa i taua tuatau ra, e ora`anga ngere e te veve maata. Ko te ti a te au `apiianga e inu ana i te reira tuatau, e rau remene te reira. I te au popongi ka tunu te au `apiianga vaine i te vai vera ei pāi no te puapii maata, e ka kimi katoa ratou i te uā moa ki runga i te maunga ei kai ti (breakfast) na te puapii maata. Ko te tautai e te tanu kai, e au `anga`anga putuputu ia na te au `apiianga tane o te reira tuatau ei tauturu ia ratou e tereni Orometua ra. Kareka ko te tua o te `apii i te tuatau tika a te Atua, e turanga meitaki e te matūtū tikai.

I taua tuatau katoa ra, te pakari ra te ture no te aravei, e te kimi vairakau ki te au taunga Maori. Karē tetai `apii`anga e `akatika`ia kia aravei i tetai uatu taunga Maori. Ko te tumu kua irinaki`ia i taua tuatau ra e, ko te `anga`anga a te au Taunga e `anga anga ia na te diabolo. E no teia tei irinaki`ia kua riro teia e, ko tetai apa maata ia i Takamoa i taua tuatau ra. Inara. no te tu apikepik e maki o tetai au Mama `apiianga kua aravei atu e toru `apiianga vaine i tetai taunga Maori i Avarua no te kimi vairakau Maori. I roto i taua tokotoru ra, ko Mama Poutapu Rasirikura tetai. Kia kiteia teia angaanga, koia oki ko te kimi i tetai ora mei te taunga Maori, kua ripoti`ia ki te puapii maata e kua riro na teia i `akaātea ia Papa Hakaoro e tona akaperepere mei roto i te aua Takamoa. Uatu oki e, kua akatika `akaou te puapii maata a Rev. William Murphy ia raua kia tomo `akaou ki Takamoa, karē ra a Mama Rasirikura i anoano `akaou i te oki ki reira. I konei i `akaoti ei te `oroanga a teia nga metua kia riro mai raua ei tavini Orometua no te Atua.

Boys' Brigade
