Akapapaia e Nga Mataio, Tekeretere Maata

1. AKATOMO'ANGA

Kia orana e te iti tangata tapu no te Atua. E tau ia tatou kia akameitaki i te mana katoatoa koia tei oronga mai i teia tikaanga manea kia aravei akaou tatou na roto i teia pepa akakitekite numero 24. To tatou tuatua aravei e te akamaroiroi i to tatou oroanga akarongo, Maseli 14.26: “*Tei te matakū i te Atua te manako matutū: e riro oki aia ei akapuanga no tana ra au tamariki; Reverence for the Lord gives confidence and security to a man and his family.*”

Ko te maataanga o te au mea i roto i teia nutileta, kua akamouia ki runga i te akakoroanga o te Uipaanga Maata e tu mai nei i teia marama ki mua, Aperira 19 – 26 ki Rarotonga nei. Te vai ra rai tetai au tuanga e tuku putuputuua iatu na, mei te akapapaanga tuatua o te au metua pakari i roto i te au Ekalesia.

Ko te nutileta openga teia i mua ake i te Uipaanga Maata. Te tamanakoanga, i roto i te marama Me e tuku iatu ei te numero 25. No reira me e au nuti ta kotou tei anoano kia tauruia ki roto i teia au tataanga ki mua, tuku mai kiaku me kore ki to tatou opati i Takamoa.

Na kotou e akatotoa atu i teia karere ki to kotou au taeake kia kite katoa ratou i te au mea e tupu nei i roto i te taokotaianga o te kopu tangata CICC. Ko kotou kare i kite ana i te au nutileta i mua atu e kua anoano kotou kia kite, aravei atu i te Orometua o taau Ekalesia me kore akakite mai kiaku; ka rauka oki te reira au nutileta i te tuku iatu na runga i te imere.



No reira me kare koe/kotou i tuku mai ake i taau/kotou, tuku viviki mai i mua ake ka pou ei teia marama Mati. Ka inangaroia oki tetai tuatau no te neneianga (duplication) kia papa ua ki te vairanga, kia kore e maata te ororo aere anga i te tuatau o te uipaanga maata.

Kua akapupu mai te tangata nenei (Tekura Potoru) e kare i te mea tau kia apai mai kotou i ta kotou au ripoti kiaia kia neneiia i te tuatau o te uipaanga maata. Te irinaki atu nei e te meitaki maata rava nei te anana a te Atua i roto i to tatou rima, i roto i ta tatou tiaki anga e te arataki anga. Me ko te reira, te akameitaki atu nei to kotou au taeake i Balaclava CICC nei ia kotou katoatoa no tenana tavini anga meitaki e te maroiroi. I akakite mai ei te 1 Ariki 17: 24, “Kua tuatua maira taua vaine ra kia Elia, ‘Ko te mea teia i kite ei au e, e tangata koe no te Atua, e te tuatua a lehova i to vaa, e tuatua-mou ia.”

Te rauka katoa nei iaku i te oronga i te akameitaki ki to tatou taeake Orometua e tona tokorua, Rev Mahuta Tautu ko tei riro ei turu pakari mai i te manako no tetai ngai akamorianga no Balaclava CICC kia akatuia, e tetai kainga Orometua, hall e tetai Day Care Centre no te Ekalesia. E te au taeake te maroiroi nei ta tatou Ekalesia ‘Balaclava CICC’ i te arumaki i teia au moemoea i runga nei kia kite aia e kia mareka atu. Inara, kare atu ei e ravenga ke e kite ei e, e mareka atu ei, mari ra, auraka ta te Atua angaanga i to tatou rima kia kairoia ki ta tatou au peu tangata. Kua akakite mai rai te aposetolo a Paulo, “Na te Mesia kotou i akarangatira, kua rangatira tika ia kotou.” “Te aronga katoa i aratakiia e te Vaerua o te Atua ra, e tamariki anakeia ratou na te Atua.” E te au taeake, e tamariki tatou na te Atua, e aru i reira i ta te Atua.

Ko te moni ka pou no te akatu anga i teia au ngutuare, kua tamanakoia e mei te 4 ki te 5 anere tauatini (\$400,000 – \$500,000). E te au taeake, ka akapeea? Ka noonoo ua aina? Na te pakari te noonoo ua no te mea kua pakari. Teiea ra te mapu? E tuatau teia kia ara mai tatou auraka kia moe ua, “E ara e pure!” i akakite mai ei te Atu. No reira tena to matou akakoroanga, kua tuera te mataara no te tuku tauturu mai.



ANNEX II

THE STORY OF MISSIONARY TEAVA

(As documented by author Richard Lovett)

In his work among the heathen, Teava had proved himself apt to teach and as the result of his labors, whole tribes abandoned idolatory and expressed their readiness to place themselves under Christian instruction. He was the first Christian evangelist sent to Samoa and Manono, and in the Samoan Islands he spent more than 20 years. With his life in his hand, writes Mr. Buzacott, he traveled in an open canoe from island to island striving to remove the prejudices of the people, and to prepare the natives to receive European missionaries. He subsequently returned to his native island of Rarotonga, where he spent the evening of his days.

During the last 9 years I have seen much of Teava, and learned to admire the man. He lived much in prayer, and in the study of God's word. At prayer-meetings he was always first there, coming at least half an hour before anyone else so that he might have time to pray and receive a blessing for himself and others before the service began. He was never absent from the deacons' Saturday afternoon prayer-meeting. He was always ready to speak to the church, ever pointing the members to Christ and warning them against the many evils to which they are exposed. From his long, true and earnest life, he was able to speak to them as only very few could. He spoke very plainly, not at all mincing matters when occasion required. He had great regard for the *Pilgrim's Progress*, and his delight was to have me sit with him and go over a part of Christians' journey to Mount Zion, the heavenly Jerusalem.

From his position in the island he was able to speak faithfully to the chiefs. He rejoiced greatly in the good the present Makea has been the means of doing. For 5 weeks before his death he was unable to attend the services in church, but he welcomed any who could spend a short time with him in prayer in his own house. He told me some days before he died that he was just waiting on; he knew the Master had sent for him. He said he was done with all below, and looked only for Christ's presence. Not in what he had done did he trust, but in the cross of Christ alone. On 16 March he asked for a little food. It was given him but he could not eat it; he got up and walked a very short distance in the house, then he said "I think the messenger has come to fetch me; I shall die." His wife and another woman laid him down on his mat, when he quietly passed away. Teava died in the spring of 1876.

What a change! In his youth he was a heathen, had fought with, and had captured men and cooked and helped to eat them. In his manhood he was converted to Christ, became a true soldier of the Cross, and led many to the Saviour. In his death he trusted alone to Christ, conquered death in Christ, and went up to hear Him say, "Well done, good and faithful servant, enter thou into the joy of thy Lord."

Some of the old English expressions are no longer used today. Note: there was no mention of Teava's second name in the autobiography and it is not clear whether Teava is the family or surname.

2. Country/island-level Council (*konitara enua, e.g. Aitutaki, NZ, Australia*)

- Prepare and conduct the regular meetings of the council
- Spearhead implementation of resolutions passed by the council for the benefit of branches under the jurisdiction of the council
- Formulate remits for submission to the general assembly
- For NZ and Australia, the secretariat will be responsible for writing reports for tabling in the general assembly
- Conflict resolution – deal with problems that may arise in the branches; if they cannot be resolved, refer them to the Executive Council
- In the case of NZ and Australia, implement the policy on establishing new church branches adopted in 2007
- Monitor implementation of those policies and resolutions passed by the general assembly that will impact on council member churches
- Devise a work programme for the council for its consideration prior to implementation
- Set and advise as appropriate, group visitation programmes

3. Regional-level Council (*konitara tuanga enua, e.g. NSW, [Aust.], Southland [NZ]*)

- Prepare and conduct the regular meetings of the council
- Spearhead implementation of resolutions passed by the council for the benefit of branches under the jurisdiction of the council
- In the case of NZ and Australia, formulate remits for submission to the country-level council
- Conflict resolution – deal with problems that may arise in the branches; if they cannot be resolved, refer them to the country/island-level council in the first instance, or the Executive Council if necessary
- In the case of NZ and Australia, the regional-level council is expected to advise the country-level council on possible new church branches
- Monitor implementation of those policies and resolutions passed by the general assembly that will impact on council member churches
- Devise a work programme for the council for its consideration prior to implementation
- Set and advise as appropriate, group visitation programmes

4. City/town-level Council (*konitara oire, e.g. Wellington, Auckland, Sydney*)

- Prepare and conduct the regular meetings of the council
- Spearhead implementation of resolutions passed by the council for the benefit of branches under the jurisdiction of the council

- Conflict resolution – deal with problems that may arise in the branches; if they cannot be resolved, refer them to the country/island-level council in the first instance, or the Executive Council if necessary
- In the case of NZ and Australia, formulate remits for submission to the country-level council
- In the case of NZ and Australia, the city/town-level council is expected to advise the country-level council on possible new church branches
- Monitor implementation of those policies and resolutions passed by the general assembly that will impact on council member churches
- Devise a work programme for the council for its consideration prior to implementation
- Set and advise as appropriate, group visitation programmes

5. No Council required

Where there is only one church branch on an island or in a city (e.g. Atiu, Townsville, Rotorua), there will be no council. A council will only exist where there is more than one church branch as in the examples given above.
